Eligibility

The contest is open to Wisconsin high school seniors attending public, private, parochial, or home schools. The contest is also open to already enrolled college students. Applicants must be accepted at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester, including but not limited to four-year college/university, two-year college/university, junior college/university, technical college/university, and vocational college/university. Board Members of Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt and members of their families are not eligible to participate.

Application Process

- Applicants must provide a college transcript for the upcoming semester.
- Applicants must provide a typed completed application form.
- Applicants must submit a typed 1.5 spaced essay of how you have unselfishly volunteered to give back to your community or an organization.
- Must be available October 26, 2024, to receive the scholarship in person at the Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt event.

Winner

There will be two \$1,000 winners of the scholarship. Winners will be announced on or before September 14th, 2024. The winners will be made aware with a phone call from a board member of the Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt. The winners must attend Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt on October 26th, 2024, to receive the scholarship. Scholarship presentation will be done around 12 o'clock before the raffle starts.
